SUBJECT: NOTICE OF RETIREMENT BOARD ELECTION

A Retirement Board seat will become vacant at the end of a term of office on February 20, 2026.

Under the Charter and the San Francisco Administrative Code, whenever the term of office of an elected Retirement Board member expires, an election is held to fill the expected vacancy. The Retirement Board announced the upcoming vacancy at its July 9, 2025 meeting. The election will be held during the period from Monday, January 12, 2026 to Friday, January 30, 2026.

For your information and guidance, a "Notice of Retirement Board Election" is enclosed. Please post this notice in a conspicuous place in each of your worksites or locations. We seek widespread distribution so employees and retirees may be notified of the forthcoming election.

Please note that the period for nominations is from Tuesday, October 7, 2025 to Friday, November 7, 2025.

RETIREMENT BOARD ELECTION

To all active and retired members of the San Francisco City and County Employees' Retirement System ("Retirement System"): Please take notice that the term of one of the three elected members of the Retirement Board will expire on February 20, 2026. In accordance with Administrative Code Sections 16.550-16.565, an election will be held to fill the vacancy.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO RUN

Any active or retired member of the Retirement System is eligible to run to serve as a trustee of the Retirement Board.

NOMINATIONS OCTOBER 7, 2025 TO NOVEMBER 7, 2025

All candidates to serve as a trustee of the Retirement Board must be nominated in writing by at least twenty individuals who are members of the Retirement System. All nominations must be on an official nomination form obtained from the Retirement System and must be filed with the Retirement System no later than 5:00 pm on Friday, November 7, 2025. Nomination forms are available by contacting Jennie Ngo at (415) 487-7012 or jennie.ngo@sfgov.org.

Members nominated must verify that they accept the nomination and agree to serve if elected. Nominees must also submit financial disclosure forms. Nominees' written acceptances and disclosures must be received by the Retirement System no later than 5:00 p.m. on Monday, December 1, 2025.

After the Retirement System verifies the eligibility of each nominee and each of their nominators, and no later than 5:00 p.m. on Friday, December 5, 2025, the Retirement System will send all completed nomination forms to the Department of Elections.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO VOTE

All active and retired members of the Retirement System are eligible to vote.

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ELECTION JANUARY 12, 2026 to JANUARY 30, 2026

No later than Friday, December 26, 2025, the Department of Elections will prepare the ballots and voting packets for delivery. The voting packets will be mailed to the address provided by SFERS for each active and retired member. Each voting packet will contain the official ballot, a pamphlet containing a sample ballot, voting instructions and candidates' statements, and a return ballot envelope. Each member votes in accordance with the instructions, placing the voted ballot inside the return ballot envelope, and sealing and signing the return ballot envelope. **Failure to sign the exterior of the return envelope invalidates the ballot.** If a voter loses or spoils their official ballot, the voter may request a second ballot by contacting the Department of Elections. Packets returned undeliverable by the United States Postal Service will be forwarded by the Department of Elections to the addressee's departmental Election Officer via inter-office mail. Any voting packet that cannot be delivered by the departmental Election Officer must be returned to the Department of Elections.

DELIVERY OF VOTED BALLOTS

The **VOTED BALLOT MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF ELECTIONS** no later than **5:00 p.m., Friday, January 30, 2026**. Voted ballots can be delivered via:

1. The member's departmental Election Officer
2. U.S. Postal Service (sufficient postage required)
3. Personally to the Department of Elections

The Department of Elections is located at City Hall, 1 Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place, Room 48.

PROCESSING AND COUNTING OF BALLOTS

Beginning at 9:00 a.m., Monday, February 2, 2026, at the Department of Elections located at City Hall, 1 Dr. Carlton B. Goodlett Place, Room 48, San Francisco, the sealed envelopes containing the ballots will be opened in the presence of witnesses and ballots canvassed publicly in such manner that the identity of the individual casting any particular ballot will not be disclosed. No later than, **Friday, February 6, 2026**, the Department of Elections will certify the results of the election pursuant to Administrative Code Section 16.563. The successful candidate will become a trustee of the Retirement Board, the term of office being five years commencing February 20, 2026 and expiring February 20, 2031.
